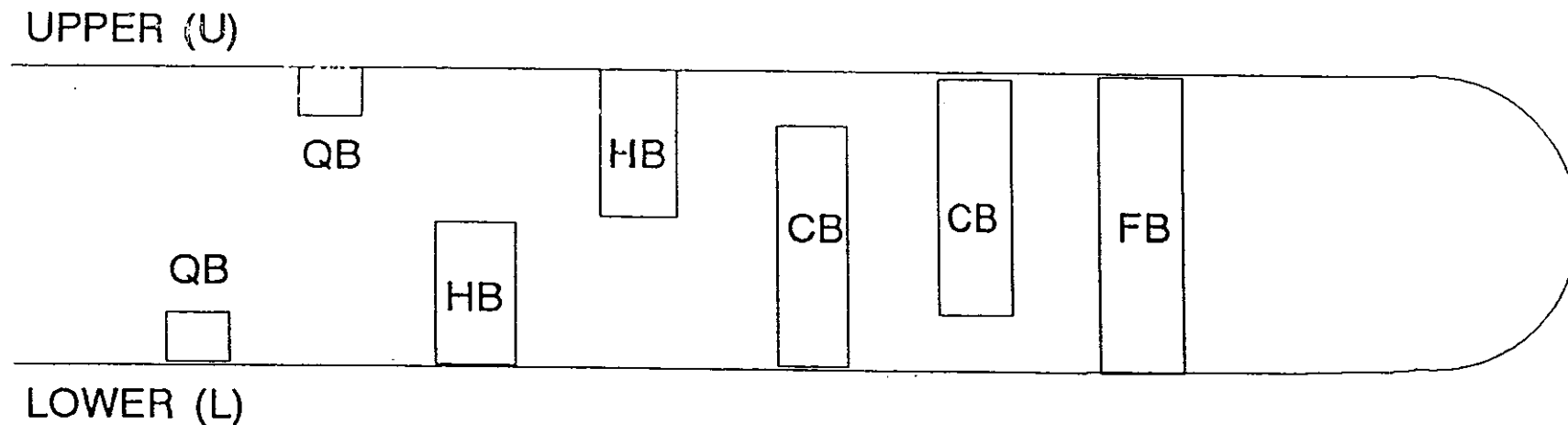

Abstract: A system to identify and describe cheetah's individuals by their tail pattern

CHEETAH TAIL IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM



Each cheetah's tail is unique.

The pattern is made up of four different length bands:

[FULL, (FB)] | [THREE FOURTHS, (CB)]

[ONE HALF, (HB)] | [ONE QUARTER, (QB)]

Begin reading on each side after the last spot. Describe the tip after the last band on each side.

Each side is different.
