

Each cheetah's tail is unique.

The pattern is made up of four different length bands:

[FULL,(FB)]| [THREE FOURTHS,(CB)]

[ONE HALF, (HB)] | [ONE QUARTER, (QB)]

Begin reading on each side after the last spot. Describe the tip after the last band on each side. Each side is different.
